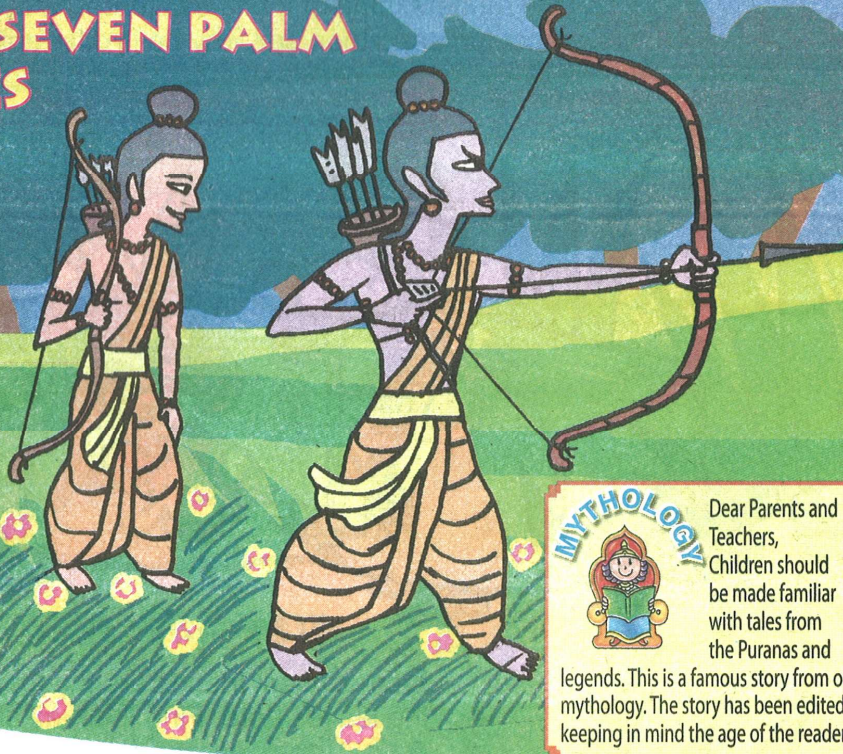


LORD RAMA AND THE SEVEN PALM TREES
